








Percent of Eligible Medicare Nonmetropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage in Arkansas, June 2011

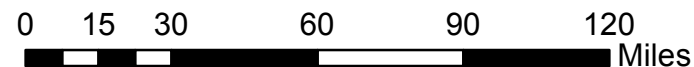
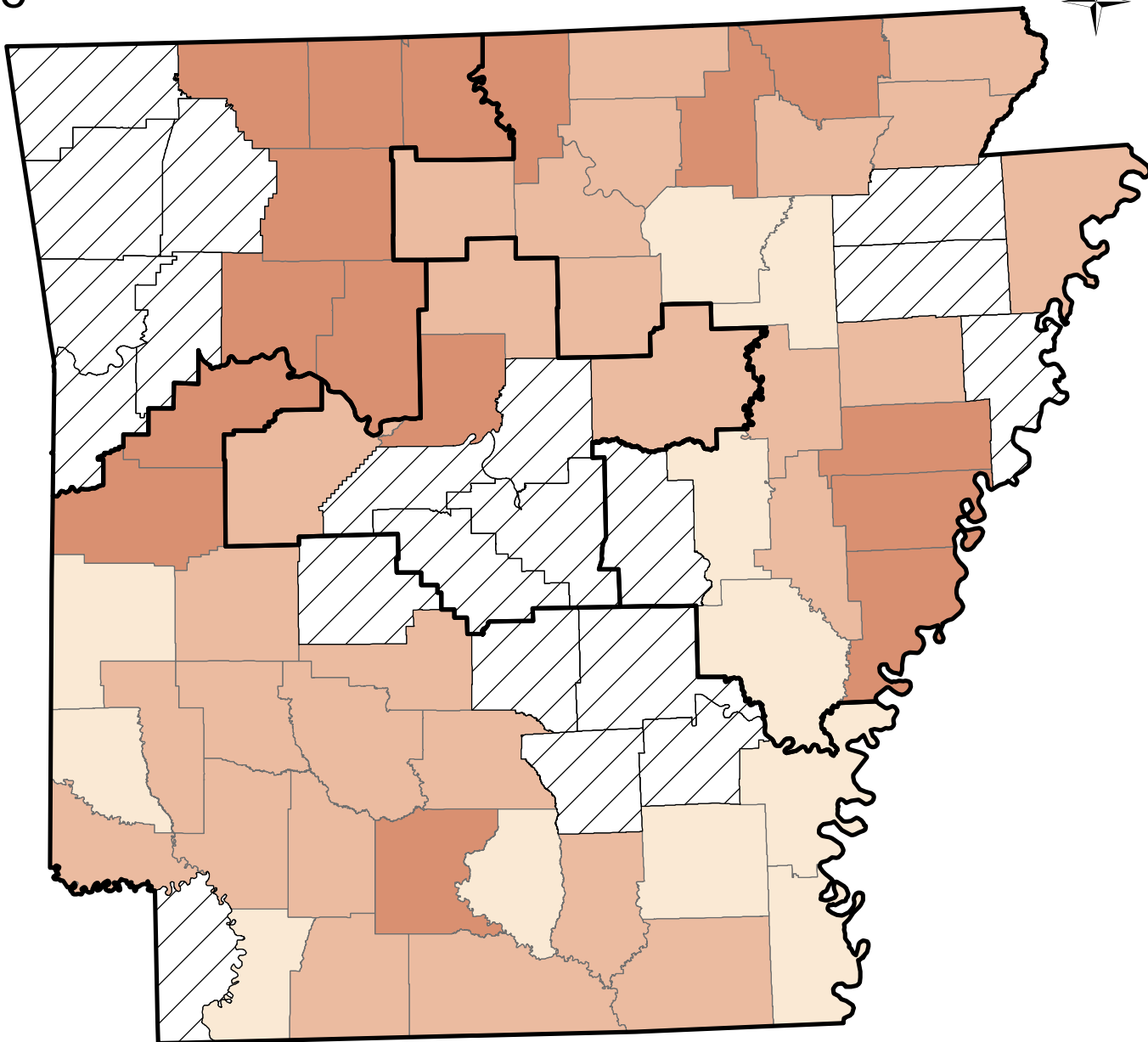



Enrolled in Preferred Provider Organizations in Arkansas, June 2011

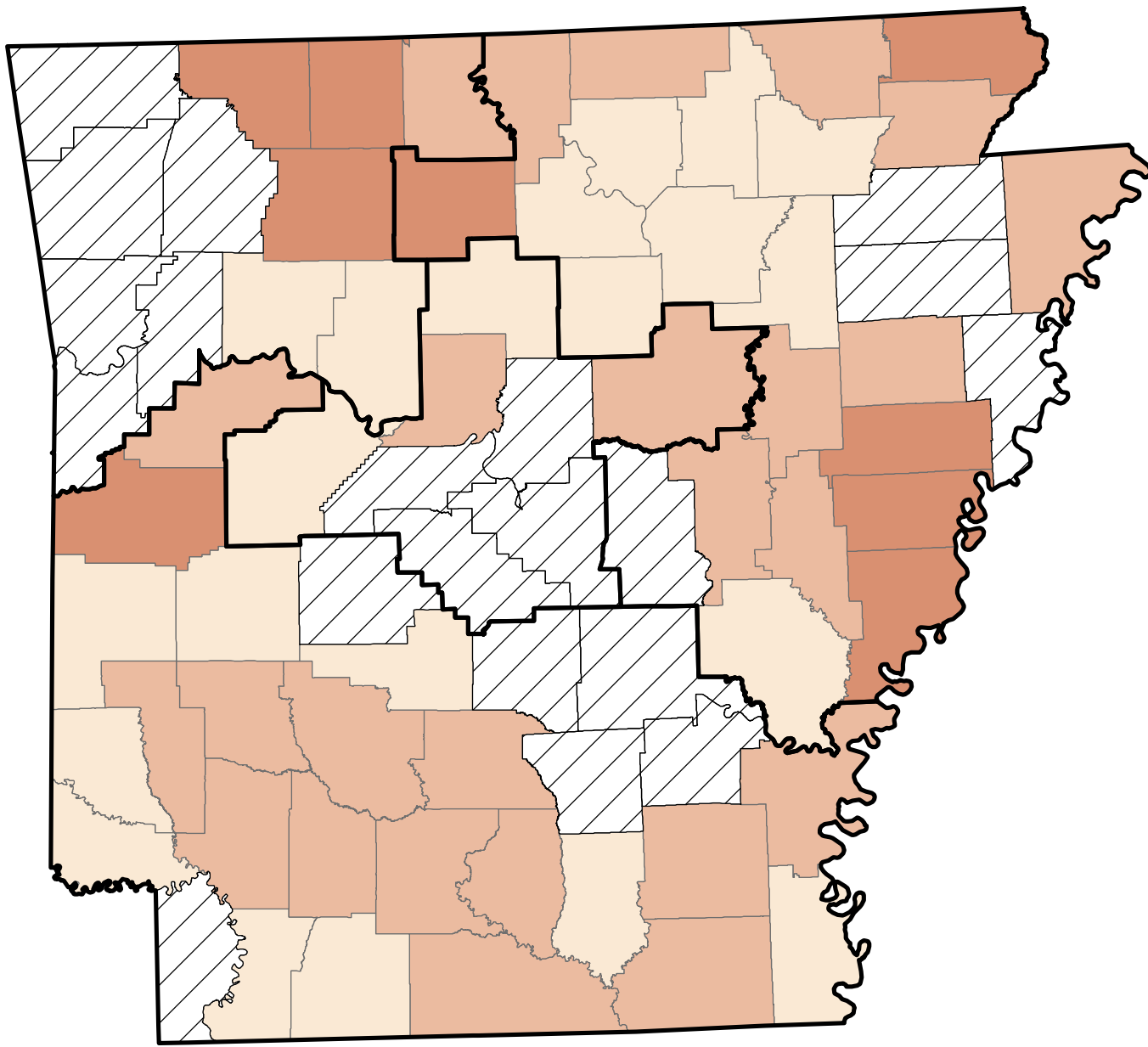
