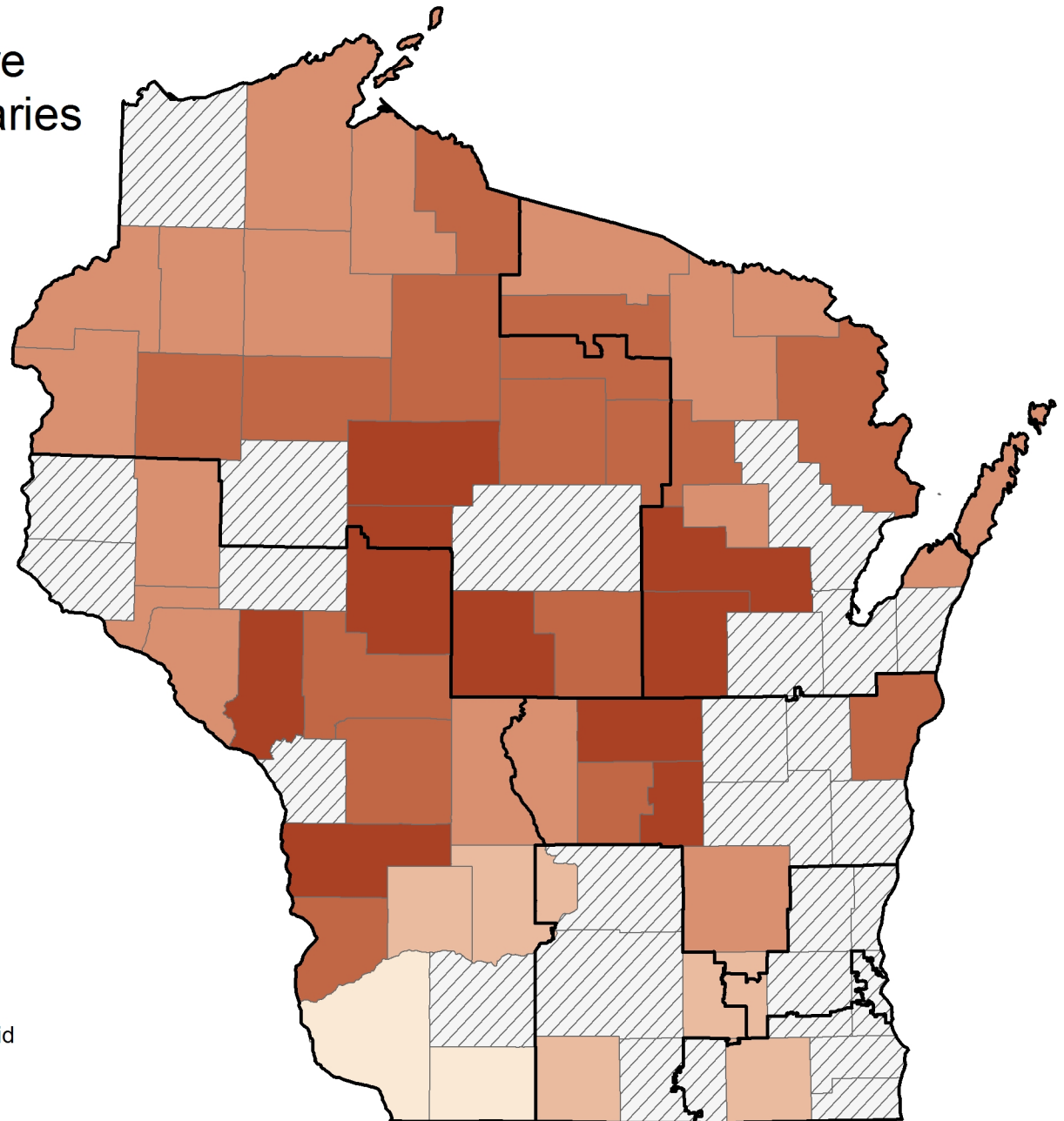









# Percent of Eligible Medicare Non-Metropolitan Beneficiaries Enrolled in Medicare Advantage in Wisconsin, March 2012

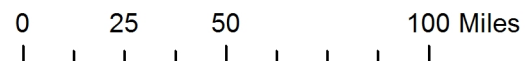

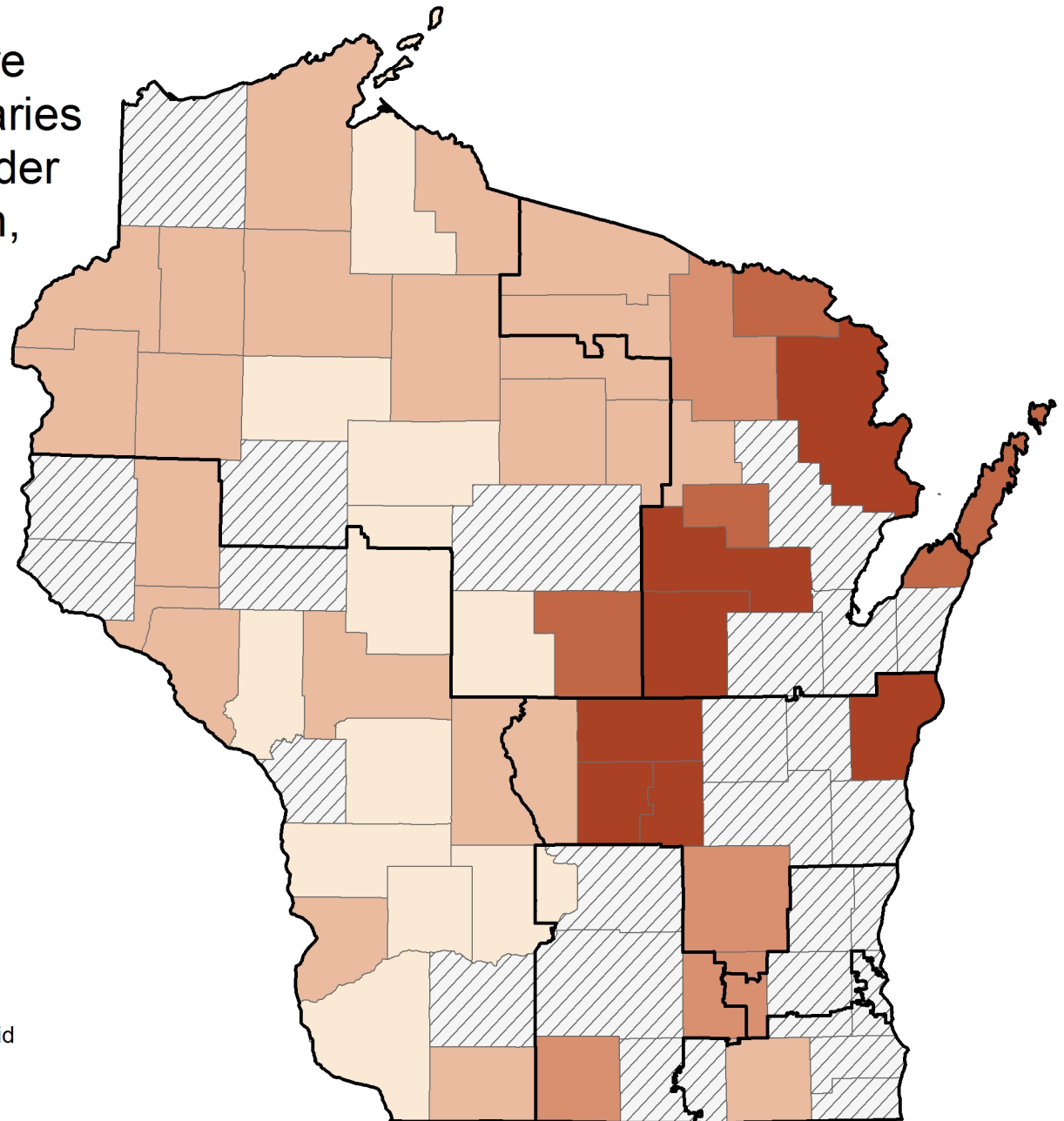
